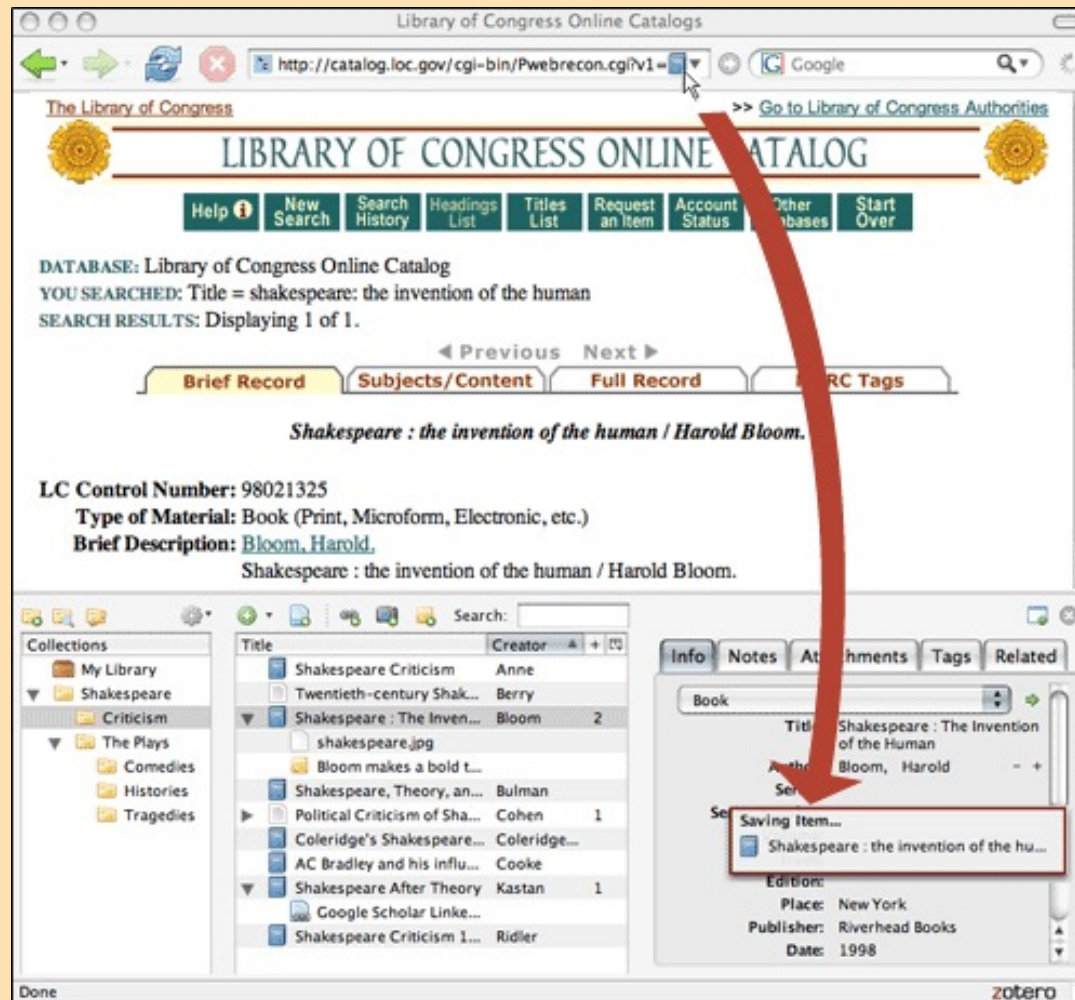
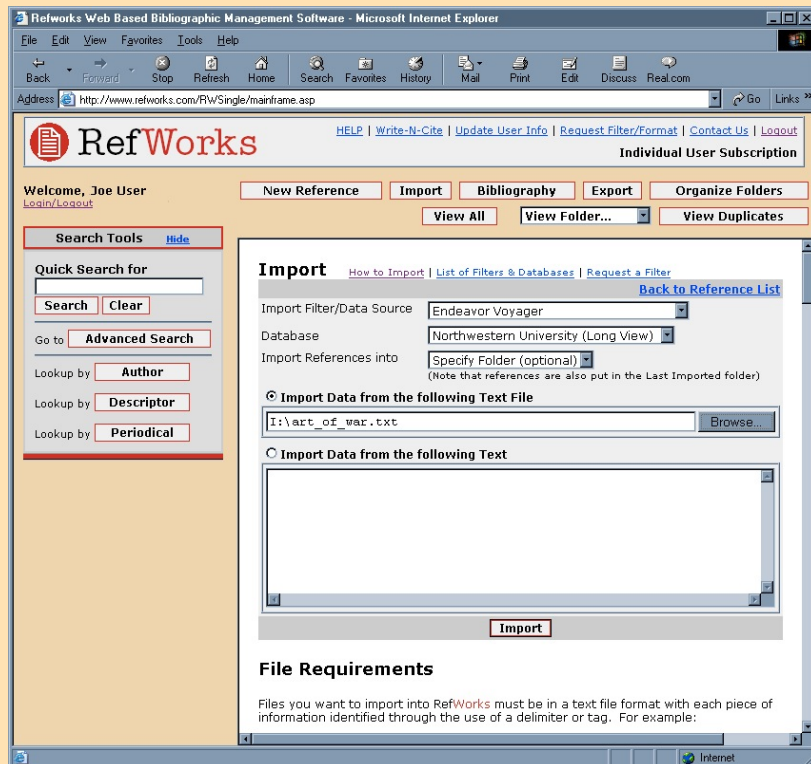

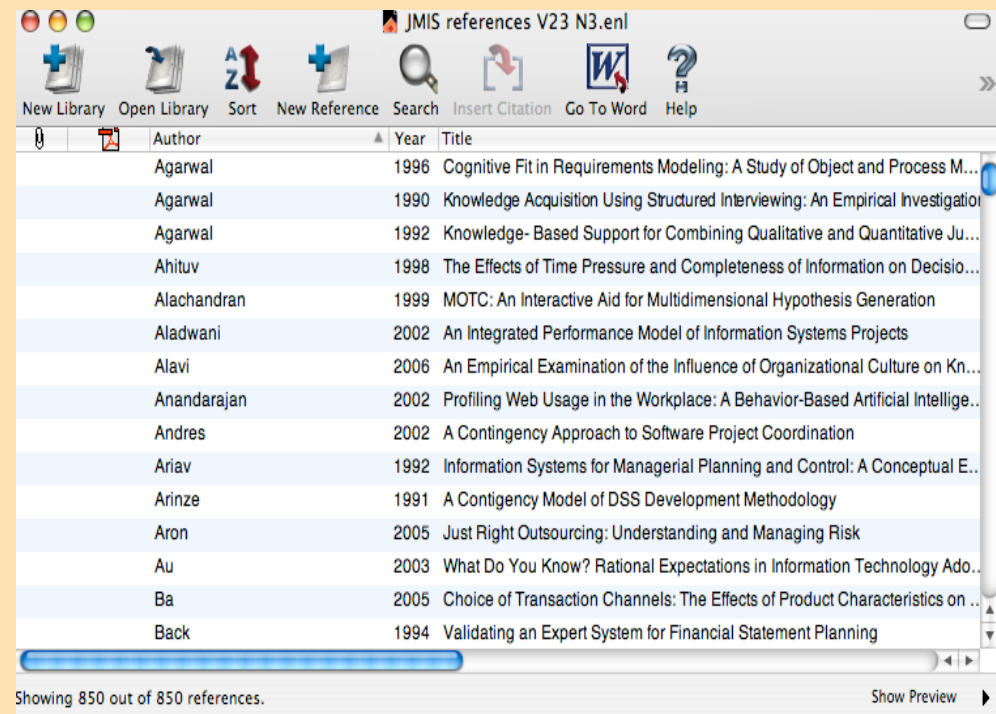

Scrapes info off the pages: We support a array of metadata standards. (Like Dublin Core and COinS)

But most of the heavy lifting is done by translators individually made for specific sites

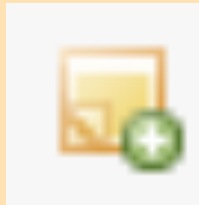
Gathering Resources



Zotero Currently supports every major library OPAC system, as well as wide variety of online archives like Jstor, and PubMed and commercial sites like Amazon

By assigning tags to my thoughts I can see them pop up when I sift through my tags in the tag selector box. I can also add related items, like books and articles through the related button at the bottom.

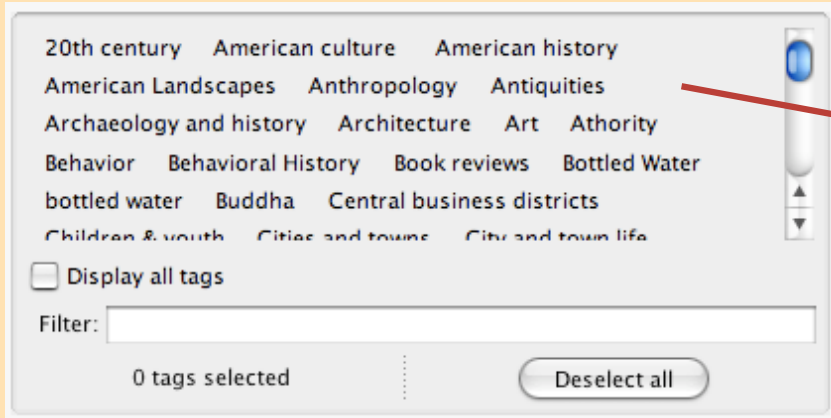

Since October the forums have received more than 1300 posts in 372 distinct threads

Many of our page translators were created by members of the user community



Zotero currently includes 11 foreign locales, all user-contributed.

“Zotero” now appears on more than half a million web pages, up from just 1 last October

But it only works with Mozilla

Yes, but so should you!



Mozilla allows 3rd party extensions- Part of Mozilla's open source mission is to support extensions of the existing program. Simply put, it is not possible to do Zotero in Internet Explorer

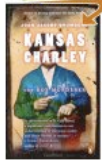

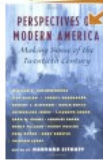

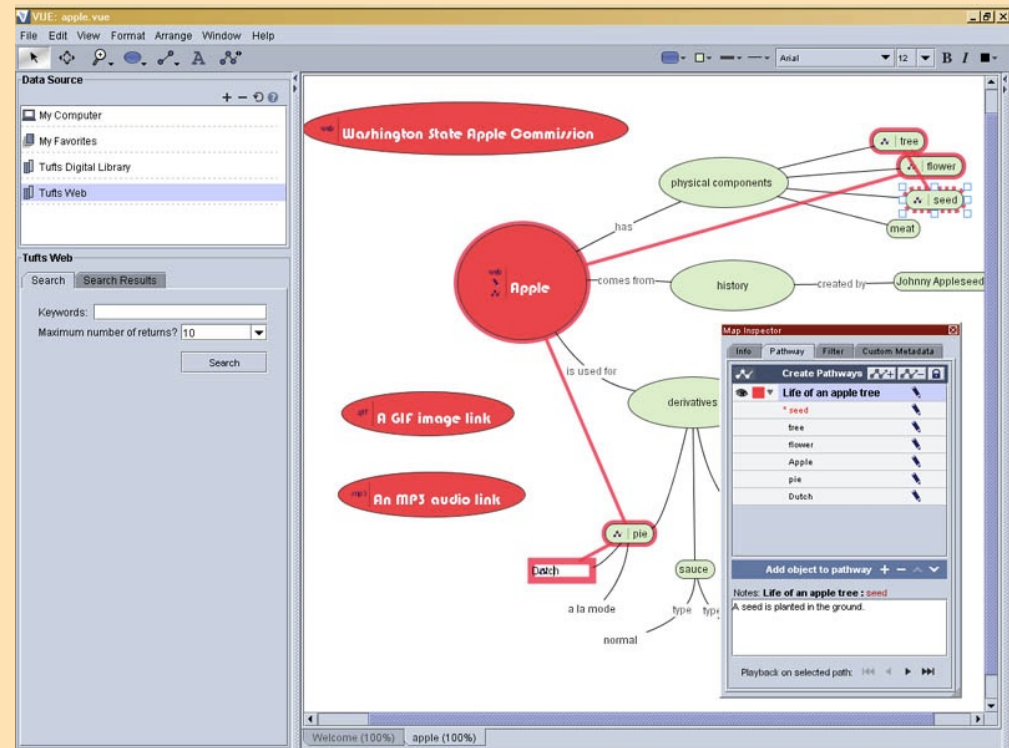
