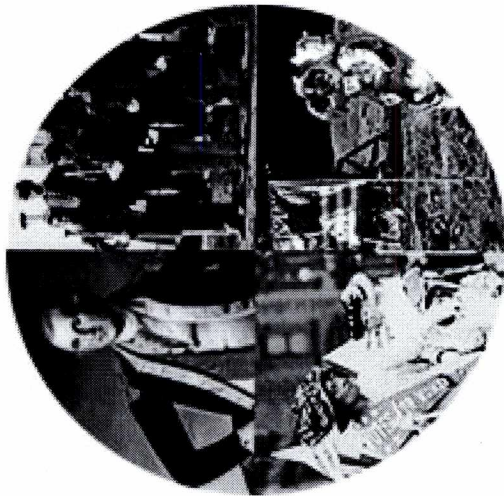


Peopling the American Past
