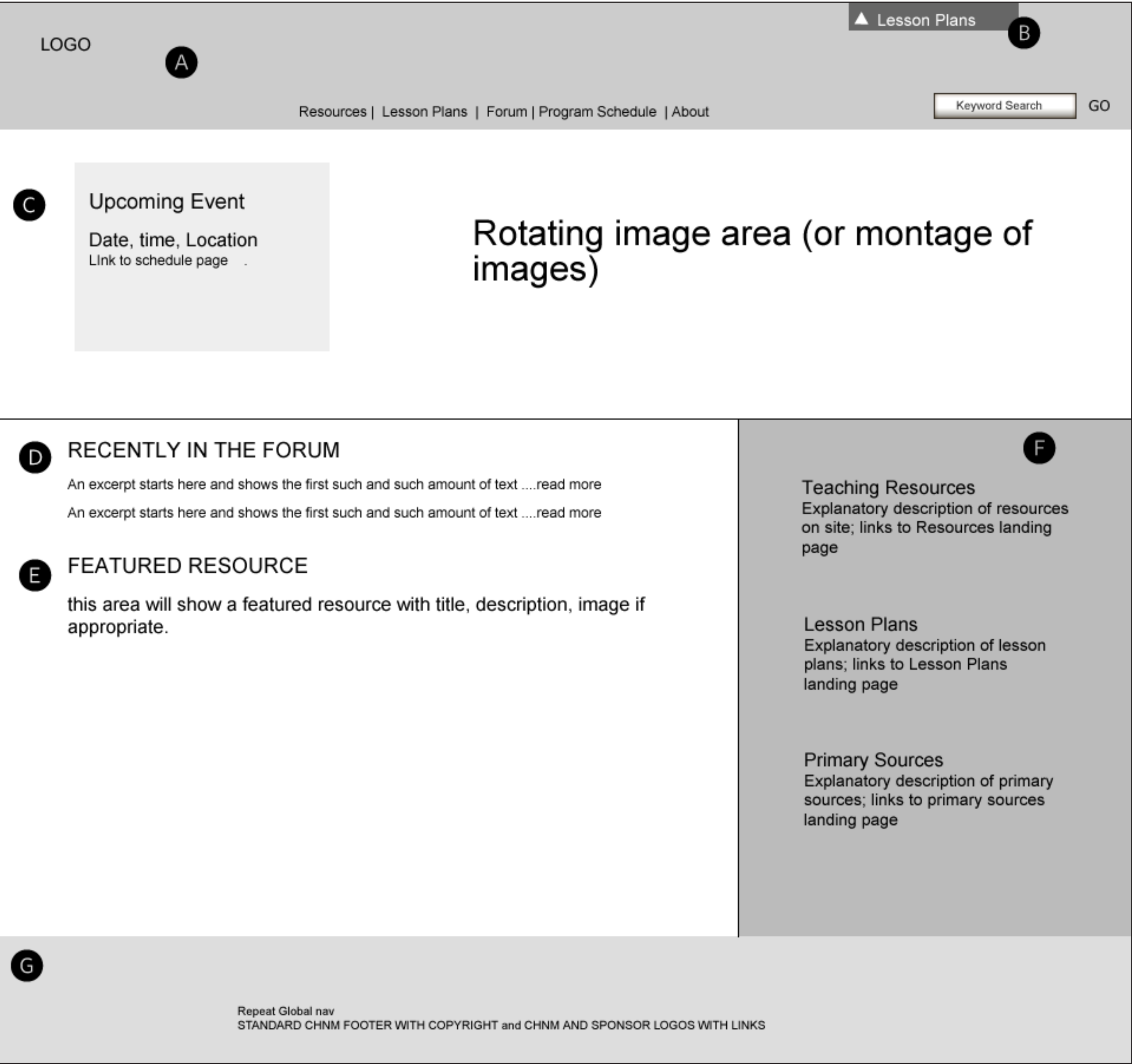
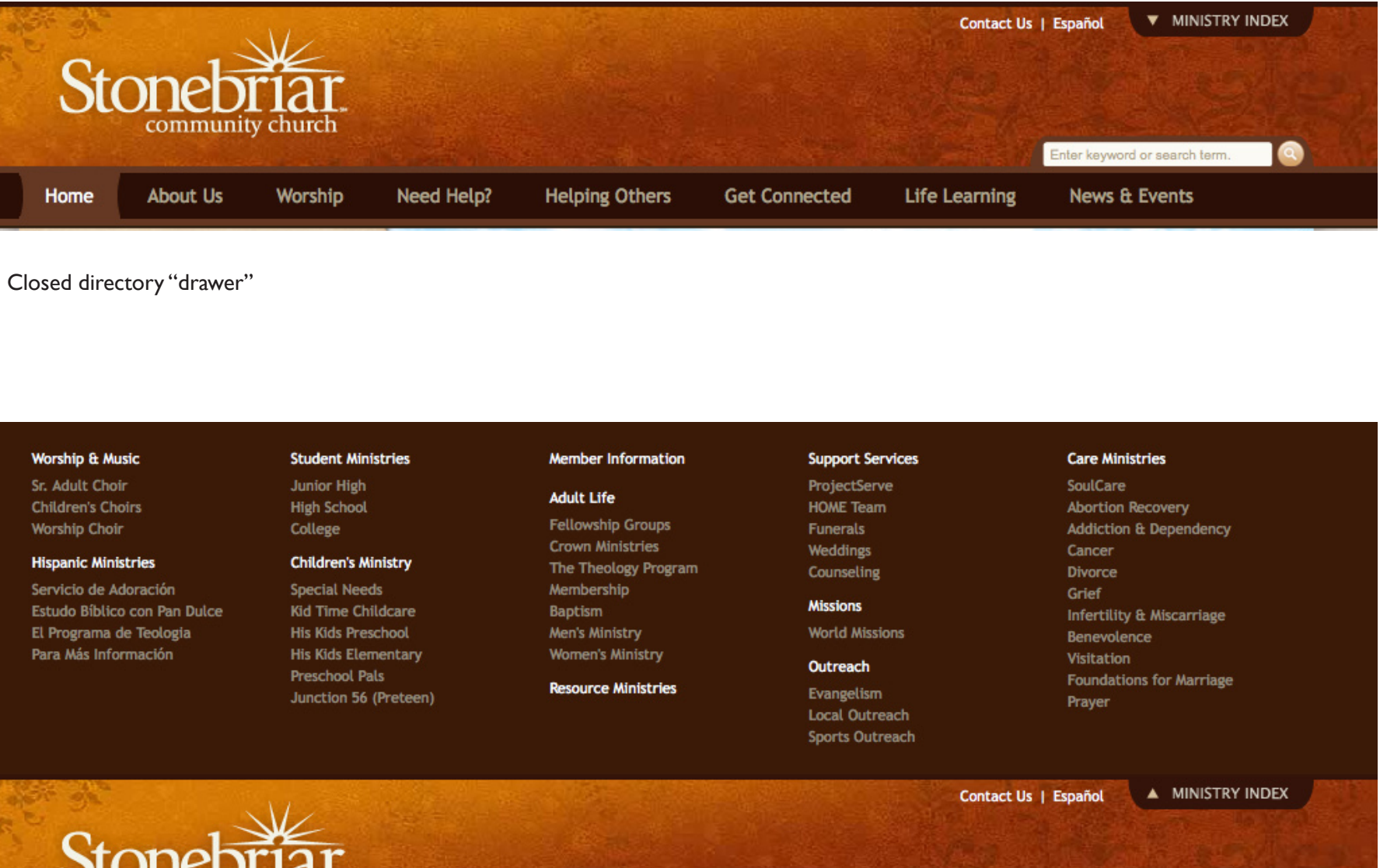




Notes:

This concept is targeted more toward the program participant, because it puts an Upcoming event right at top, and the Resources for the wider audience in the sidebar. It also emphasizes the community aspect by putting Recently in Forum above Featured Resource.

- A.The header area, includes logotype, global navigation, search, and a “drawer” (B.) to open a full directory of lesson plans. (See below for a visual example of what this is).
- C.The most visually prominent block, includes the next upcoming event for program participants, and an image area--could be rotating images or a single montage of“everyday people”.
- D. Self-explanatory

C. The most visually prominent block, includes the brief site description and links to the resources (I was not sure if there were 2 or if there would also be a Primary Sources link).

D. This can include both a calendar (this one's just for demonstration purposes, we can style it to fit the site) and description of one or more upcoming events.
